The highlight of the trip, however, was meeting Patrick Ales, the legendary founder and CEO of the Phyto group, whose products we have so successfully used here in Studio Booth. 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"Friends have invited us for a barbecue next weekend and we need to bring a covered dish. Everything they do is over the top, so bringing Grandma's potato salad is out of the question. Help!

The bottom line...it's still a barbecue, so take something appropriate. I have the perfect recommendation for you; Northern Thai BBQ wings. This recipe is from my chef buddy, Rich Rosenthal. Most of you know his wife, Cherry, from Trader Joe's. I love cooking with them, along with Noi Chaisri, who owns "Thai Me Up" on Carson Street (check it out!) We have made a lot of great Thai recipes together. This is probably my favorite. It looks and tastes amazing!

Combine spices and toss to coat chicken wings. Marinate overnight. Grill over medium heat for 5-7 minutes.

Ingredients:

- 1/4 c. salt
- 1 c. lemongrass, finely chopped
- 32 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tsp. white pepper
- 1 c. cilantro, chopped
- 4 tsp. turmeric
- 6 lbs. chicken wings
